A number of buildings in London designed by Foster + Partners will also be accessible during Open House 2012. These include Capital City Academy (Brent), City Hall (Southwark), One Bishops Square (Tower Hamlets), 30 St Mary Axe, The Gherkin, (City of London), Bloomberg LT (Islington) and the Sackler Galleries at the Royal Academy of Arts (Westminster).

Open House London is an annual celebration of the capital's architecture, now in its 20th year. It takes place during the weekend of 22-23 September 2012, when more than 750 buildings, many of which are normally closed, are opened to the public. It is a wonderful opportunity to celebrate the richness of London's architectural heritage.
